# **1. Introduction**

The Legacy File System Extension is an optional upgrade to the LTO Server Edition of XenData Archive Series software. It adds read-only support for LTO cartridges written using the following proprietary formats:

- Active Circle
- Generic TAR (for example from Cache-A)
- Raw Tape (files on tape, separated by file marks)

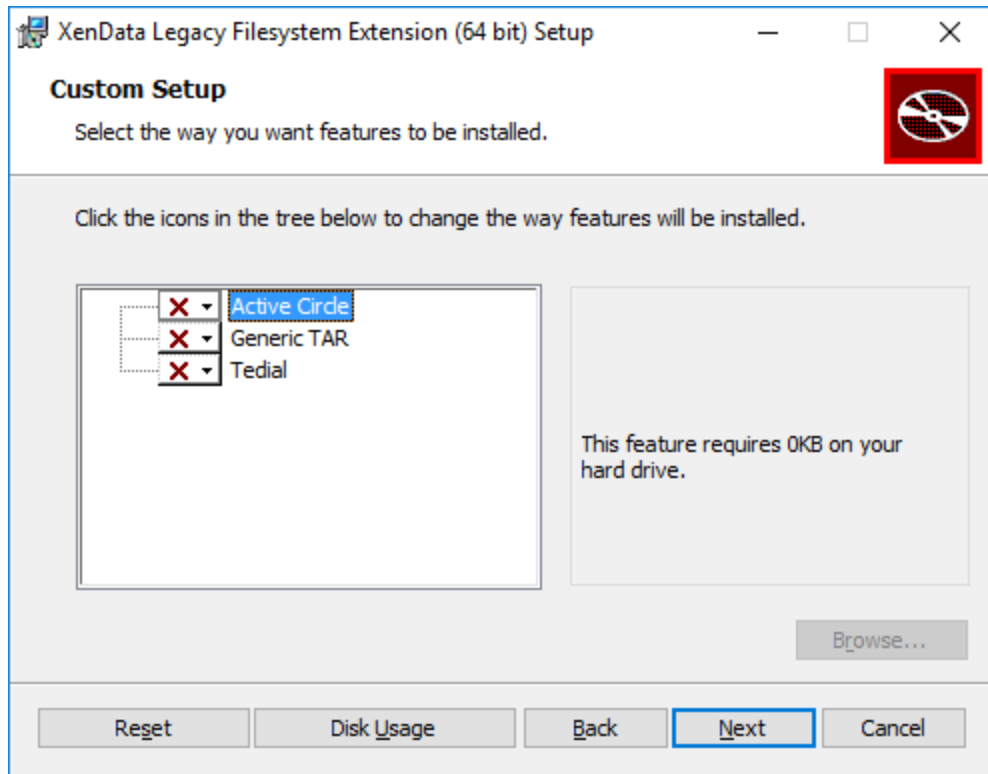
## **2. Requirements**

Version 7.11 or higher of XenData Archive Series, LTO Server Edition.

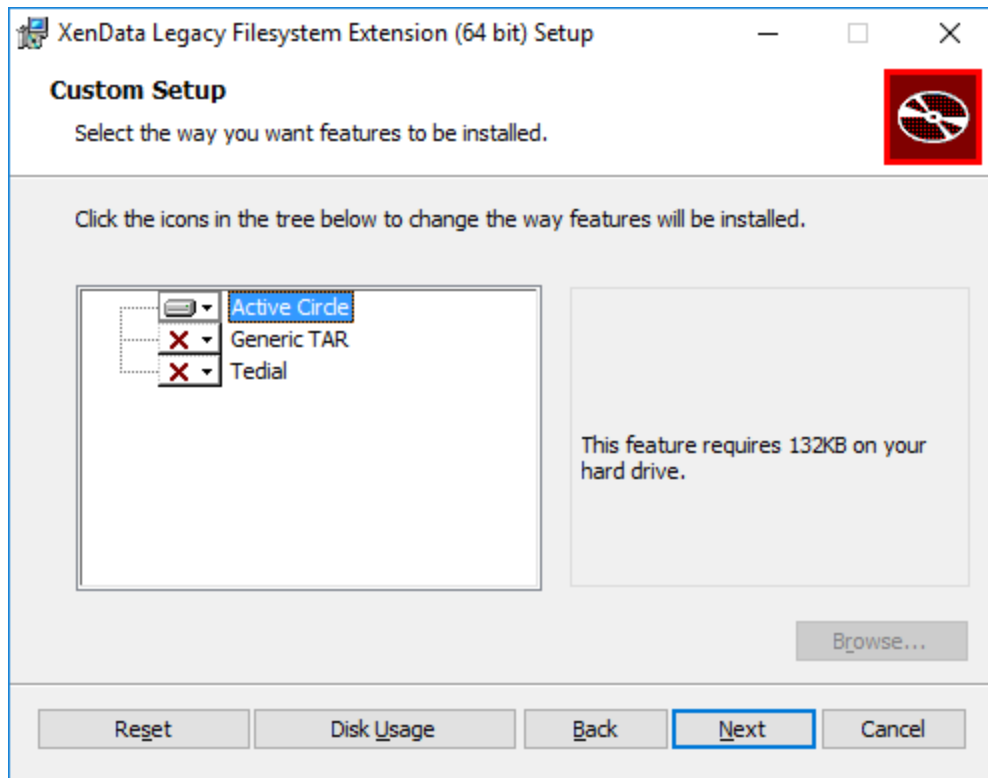
## **3. Installation**

After the LTO Server Edition of XenData Archive Series software is installed on the system, follow the below steps to install the Legacy File Systems Extension.

1. Download the XDLegacyFileSystemsx64-v.vv.bbbb.xxx.msi (where v.vv is the version number, bbbb is the build number and xxx is a build type).
2. Run XDLegacyFileSystemsx64-v.vv.bbbb.xxx.msi
3. Click 'Next' on the first screen that appears.
4. Click on the 'I accept the terms in the License Agreement' check box, then click 'Next'.
5. Select the features you require, select the option to install it on the local hard drive and click next.







6. Click on 'Install' to begin the installation of the selected features.
7. Once the installation has completed, click on 'Finish'.
8. Restart the XenData Archive Series Service, or reboot the server.
