



After the LTO Server Edition of XenData Archive Series software is installed on the system, follow the below steps to install the Legacy File Systems Extension.

- 1. Download the XDLegacyFileSystemsx64-v.vv.bbbb.xxx.msi (where v.vv is the version number, bbbb is the build number and xxx is a build type).
- 2. Run XDLegacyFileSystemsx64-v.vv.bbbb.xxx.msi
- 3. Click 'Next' on the first screen that appears.
- 4. Click on the 'I accept the terms in the License Agreement' check box, then click 'Next'.
- 5. Select the features you require, select the option to install it on the local hard drive and click next.





- 6. Click on 'Install' to begin the installation of the selected features.
- 7. Once the installation has completed, click on 'Finish'.
- 8. Restart the XenData Archive Series Service, or reboot the server.
